

## Parent information for 2 week topic on Judaism

For the next two weeks year two will be learning about Judaism.

Learning objectives will include..

- To know the story of the birth of Isaac
- To know that a synagogue is important to Jewish people
- To understand the importance of a Mezuzah
- To understand the importance of the ten commandments
- To understand Jewish food rules
- To know some Jewish celebrations



For the next two weeks the children will work in maths groups with either Miss Porter or Mrs Prince. Work covered will include.

- Reasoning about addition (e.g. pupil can reason that the sum of 3 odd numbers will always be odd).
- Working out mental calculations where regrouping is required (e.g.  $52 - 27$ ;  $91 - 73$ ).
- Solving more complex missing number problems (e.g.  $14 + ? - 3 = 17$ ;  $14 + \Delta = 15 + 27$ ).
- Partitioning two-digit numbers into different combinations of tens and ones.
- Using number bonds and related subtraction facts within 20 (e.g.  $18 = 9 + ?$ ;  $15 = 6 + ?$ ).
- Adding and subtracting a two-digit number and ones and a two-digit number and tens where no regrouping is required (e.g.  $23 + 5$ ;  $46 + 20$ ), they can demonstrate their method using concrete apparatus or pictorial representations.
- Adding 2 two-digit numbers within 100 (e.g.  $48 + 35$ ), demonstrating the method using concrete apparatus or pictorial representations.
- Using estimation to check that an answer to a calculation is reasonable.



In English we want the children to be confident with:-

- Using conjunctions
- Using when, if, because to write complex sentences
- Knowing the four different kinds of sentences (exclamations, questions, statements, commands)
- Using adjectives
- Using commas in lists
- Accurately spelling words from given word lists
